CITY OF LEADVILLE, COLORADO RESOLUTION NO. 4 SERIES 2021

A RESOLUTION TEMPORARILY WAIVING LIQUOR LICENSE RENEWAL FEES FOR ON-PREMISES LIQUOR LICENSEES

WHEREAS, the City of Leadville continues to be subject to executive and public health orders issued by the State of Colorado and Lake County ("Health Orders") related to severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2 ("COVID-19"); and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to use the resources it has available to support local businesses in the Leadville community and help to cushion the economic impact of COVID-19 on the City's businesses and their employees; and

WHEREAS, due to public health concerns raised by the presence of COVID-19 in Colorado, the Colorado Liquor Enforcement Division ("LED") passed Senate Bill 20B-001 – Grant Program and Waiver of Certain Liquor License Fees; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to waive City liquor licensing renewal fees for onpremises licensees on time during the period of December 7, 2020 through December 6, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Leadville, Colorado as follows:

- **Section 1.** Recitals Incorporated. The recitals contained above are incorporated herein by reference and are adopted as findings and determinations of the City Council.
- Section 2. Temporary Waiver of On-Premises Renewal Licensing Fees. The City Council hereby waives its fees for on-premises liquor license renewals. Such waiver of fees shall be in effect for the same as the State and the LED regulations, from December 7, 2020 through December 6, 2021. This Resolution temporarily waives licensing fees only and does not waive other requirements of the Leadville Municipal Code, including the requirement to obtain a license or licenses.
- **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon adoption.
