Call to order of regular council meeting at 6:01 p.m. in Council Chambers and via Zoom.

Approval of the agenda: CM Hill moved to approve the revised agenda, CM Forgensi seconded, All present were in favor

- A. Firecracker 5k TUP: No questions or concerns from Council CM Forgensi moved to approve the TUP for Sports Hall of Fame's Annual Firecracker 5k on Monday, July 4th, 2022 at 8:30 am, said approval being good for 3 years, or through 2024. CM Hill seconded; Vote was 7-0-0-0
- **B.** Main Street Summer Concert Series TUP: Council had concerns with the venue not being large enough, having more people show up than was anticipated for.

CM Luna-Leal moved to approve Temporary Use Permit for LLCEDC/LMSP to host the Summer Concert Series on Thursdays, July 7th, August 4th & September 1st, 2022 from 4:00 pm until 7:00 pm, on the condition that the applicant adhere to the points recommended by LLCFR; CM Lauritzen seconded, Vote was 7-0-0-0

C. Main Street Music in the Park Funding Request:



CM Tharp moved to approve the Request for Funds for \$3,000.00 by Leadville Main Street Program to cover the cost of music production only, CM Forgensi seconded, Vote was 7-0-0-0 MPT Greene had to leave at 8:00 pm

D. 322-324 Harrison Ave STR CUP:

CM Hill moved to close the public input portion of the meeting, CM Forgensi seconded, all present were in favor. CM Forgensi moved to approve the Conditional Use Permit for Alternative Industrial Solutions, LLC for use of licensing three short term rental license units at 322/324 Harrison Ave, Leadville CO 80461. This is based on the criteria set forth in the staff report dated April 14th, 2022, the City of Leadville's municipal code sections 17.52.040, 5.12.090, the 2015 Leadville Comprehensive Plan and the specifications as discussed and determined by this hearing for the sort-term rental use. I further move to have this CUP approval sunset with the applicant and current owner as required in the above sections of city code; CM Hill seconded, Vote was 6-0-0-1

E. 210 E 10th St Elevated Wholesale MJ Cultivation-Renewal:

Marijuana Licensing Authority called to order a public hearing at 8:16 pm. CM Hill moved to close the public input portion of the meeting, CM Luna-Leal seconded, all present were in favor. CM Hill moved to approve the annual renewal on 4/19/2022 for the retail cultivation license for Josh Meyers DBA Elevated Quality Wholesale, LLC at 210 E 10th St; CM Tharp seconded, Vote was 6-0-0-1

CM Luna-Leal moved to approve Temporary Use Permit for Elevation Goods to host a Birthday Celebration on Saturday, April 30th, 2022 from 11:00 am until 5:00 pm; CM Hill seconded, Vote was 6-0-0-1
