### Discussion about snow removal -

Discussions are in the works between the city and county to start a cooperative pilot program for snow removal on city streets between the city and county. More information will be presented in September.

## Follow-up sidewalk bids and timing discussion -

Council would like to continue with the process, but we must make sure that it won't be permitted to move forward until the CDOT paving is completed (estimate mid-September). Also, if it can't be completed by this fall (end of October), then Council said would prefer to wait until next spring.

## Discussion regarding TOH waterline consideration -

There was a conversation between the mayor, Cody Hall and Greg Tetter about work that will need to be done at the TOH, which includes the waterline, sewer line and storm sewer, to see if this work should be done this year before Parkville digs up Harrison Avenue and repaves. Unfortunately, due to the scope and cost of this work it will have to wait until a later date.
