**A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BY AND
BETWEEN THE CITY OF LEADVILLE AND LAKE COUNTY FOR THE PROVISION
FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES**

WHEREAS, the City of Leadville has the authority to enter into intergovernmental agreements pursuant to C.R.S. § 29-1-203; and

WHEREAS, the City is authorized to establish and maintain a fire department and to acquire fire fighting equipment pursuant to C.R.S. § 31-15-601 (1); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to such statutory authority, the City has established and operates and maintains a fire department; and

WHEREAS, the County is authorized pursuant to §§ 30-25-1 06(1) and 30-10-513, C.R.S. to appropriate money for the purpose of controlling fires in the county and to allow municipal fire departments such compensation and other expenses as the County deems necessary; and


WHEREAS, the City and County are authorized pursuant to C.R.S. §29-1-203 to cooperate and contract with one another to provide any function, service or facility lawfully authorized to each of the cooperating or contracting units; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to approve the attached intergovernmental agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEADVILLE, THAT:


