**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEADVILLE,
COLORADO, DECLARING A VACANCY IN OFFICE FOR A CITY COUNCIL
MEMBER REPRESENTING WARD 2 AS OF JUNE 15, 2018 AND DETERMINING
TO FILL SUCH VACANCY BY APPOINTMENT**

WHEREAS, Section 2.04.010 of the Leadville Municipal Code states that the City Council shall be composed of the Mayor and six City Council Members elected from the three wards of the City; and

WHEREAS, Council Member Domenic Roti, representing Ward 2, resigned from his elective position of City Council Member; and

WHEREAS, Council Member Roti's resignation created a vacancy in office as of June 15, 2018; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with C.R.S. §§ 31-4-106 and 31-4-108(2)(b), the City Council must either appoint a person to fill the vacancy within sixty (60) days of the vacancy or schedule a special election; and

WHEREAS, City Council desires to appoint a person to fill the vacancy in order to save time and the expense of conducting a special election; and

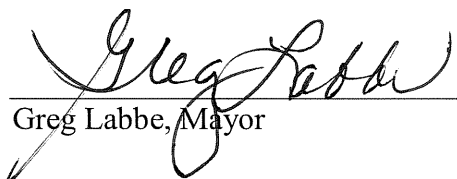
WHEREAS, City Council further desires City Staff to advertise the vacancy to seek a qualified candidate to fill the vacancy in Ward 2 as soon as reasonably practicable so that the City has a full City Council seated without unnecessary delay.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Leadville, Colorado as follows:

Section 1. The City Council hereby: (1) declares that beginning on June 15, 2018, a vacancy was created in the office of City Council Member for Ward 2; (2) determines that it is appropriate to appoint a person to fill the vacancy in accordance with C.R.S. §§ 31-4-106 and 31-4-108(2)(b); and (3) directs City Staff to advertise said vacancy.

Section 2. **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect upon its adoption by the City Council.
