**A RESOLUTION SETTING THE NEIGHBORHOOD BOUNDARIES TO DETERMINE NEEDS  
AND DESIRES FOR NEW LIQUOR LICENSE APPLICATIONS**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Leadville ("City") is designated as the Local Licensing Authority, pursuant to Section 5.08.010 of the Leadville Municipal Code, for liquor license applications received by the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council, acting as the Local Licensing Authority, desires to set standard boundaries for the purpose of treating all applicants for new liquor licenses as equally as possible when making determinations on whether there is a need and desire for an additional outlet as measured by the reasonable requirements of the neighborhood, the desires of the adult inhabitants of the neighborhood, and the number, type and availability of existing outlets; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds it appropriate to establish the standard boundaries for making such needs and desires determinations as the entire boundaries of the City unless good cause exists to alter such boundary for a specific application.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Leadville, Colorado as follows:


**Section 1. Boundaries Established.** For purposes of determining whether there is a need and desire for an additional outlet as measured by reasonable requirements of the neighborhood, desires of adult inhabitants of the neighborhood, and number, type and availability of existing outlets, the City Council, acting as the Local Licensing Authority, hereby defines the neighborhood as the entire boundaries of the City of Leadville, unless good cause exists to alter such boundary for a specific application.

**Section 2. Severability.** If any part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution is for any reason held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions.

**Section 3. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect upon its adoption by the City Council.
