## A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE APPLICATION FOR GRANT FUNDING FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF LOCAL AFFAIRS FOR PHASE 2 OF THE TABOR OPERA HOUSE REHABILITATION PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City of Leadville ("City") supports a grant application to the Department of Local Affairs ("DOLA") for grant funds through DOLA's Energy and Mineral Impact Assistance Fund ("EIAF") Program to contribute to the completion of Phase 2 of the rehabilitation of the exterior envelope of the City's historic Tabor Opera House ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, if the grant is awarded, the City supports the completion of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City's application ("Application") will contain a request for Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$600,000.00) from DOLA to contribute to the completion of the Project ("Grant").

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Leadville, Colorado as follows:

- <u>Section 1.</u> <u>Recitals.</u> The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein by reference as findings and determinations of City Council.
- **Section 2. Support of Grant Application.** The City Council of the City of Leadville strongly supports the Application to DOLA for the Grant through DOLA's EIAF Program.
- Section 3. Support of Project Completion. If the Grant is awarded, the City strongly supports the completion of the Project.
- <u>Section 4.</u> <u>Grant Agreement Authorization.</u> If the Grant is awarded to the City, City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to sign an agreement, if required by DOLA, for the City's receipt of the Grant.
- <u>Section 5.</u> <u>Severability.</u> If any part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution is for any reason held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions.
- Section 6. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect upon its adoption by the City Council.
