## CITY OF LEADVILLE, COLORADO RESOLUTION NO. 23 SERIES 2020

## A RESOLUTION APPOINTING A PRESIDING JUDGE AND ALTERNATE JUDGE FOR LEADVILLE MUNICIPAL COURT

- WHEREAS, the City is authorized by C.R.S. § 13-10-105 and Sections 2.12.010 and 2.40.040 of the Leadville Municipal Code to appoint a presiding municipal judge and an alternate municipal judge for the Leadville Municipal Court; and
- WHEREAS, the Municipal Code at Section 2.40.040 sets the term of the Municipal Judge at two (2) years and requires that the Municipal Judge, at all times during the term of office, be currently licensed to practice law in the State of Colorado; and
- WHEREAS, the resignation of the City's previous municipal judge on February 12, 2020 created a vacancy in the position of presiding municipal judge for the Leadville Municipal Court; and
- WHEREAS, the City engaged in a formal request for proposals ("RFP") and interview process to fill the vacancy for its presiding municipal judge and appoint an alternate judge; and
- WHEREAS, M. Christina Floyd is a licensed attorney in the State of Colorado and is qualified to serve as the Leadville's Presiding Municipal Judge; and
- WHEREAS, Jonathan Shamis is a licensed attorney in the State of Colorado, serves as a judge in Lake County Court, and is qualified to serve as Leadville's Alternate Municipal Judge; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council desires to appoint M. Christina Floyd as the City's Presiding Municipal Judge and appoint Judge Shamis as the City's Alternates Municipal Judge, which appointments shall be for two-year terms commencing on May 5, 2020.

## NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEADVILLE, COLORADO, THAT:

- Section 1. Presiding Municipal Judge Appointment. The City Council hereby appoints M. Christina Floyd as the Presiding Municipal Judge for the Leadville Municipal Court effective May 5, 2020.
- Section 2. Alternate Municipal Judge Appointment. The City Council hereby appoints Jonathan Shamis as the Alternate Municipal Judge for the Leadville Municipal Court effective May 5, 2020.

Section 3. Term. The term of appointment for both the Presiding Municipal Judge and the Alternate Municipal Judge shall be for two years and shall expire on May 4, 2022.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect upon its approval by the City Council.
