**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LEADVILLE, COLORADO  
APPOINTING A CITY TREASURER UNTIL THE NEXT REGULAR  
CITY ELECTION ON NOVEMBER 7, 2017**

**WHEREAS**, Jaime Stuever has resigned as City Treasurer; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 1.16.030 of the Municipal Code and C.R.S. § 31-4-108(2)(b) authorizes the City Council to fill any vacancy in an elective office by appointment or by election, in the case that any office of an elective officer becomes vacant before the regular expiration of the term thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 2.04.100 of the Municipal Code establishes a four-year term of office for the City Treasurer commencing with the 1977 regular City election; and

**WHEREAS**, current term of office for the City Treasurer is 2013-2017; and

**WHEREAS**, City Council desires to make an appointment to fill the vacancy in the office of City Treasurer until the November 7, 2017 regular election, at which point the office of City Treasurer shall be open for a four (4) year term, as established in Section 2.04.100 of the Municipal Code.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEADVILLE, COLORADO, THAT:**

**Section 1.** The City Council hereby appoints Elsa Tharp as the City Treasurer until the November 7, 2017 regular election, at which point the office of City Treasurer shall be open for a four (4) year term, as established in Section 2.04.100 of the Municipal Code.

**Section 2.** The appointment authorized by Section 1 above shall be effective November 17, 2016. Before entering upon the duties of the offices of City Treasurer, Elsa Tharp shall take and subscribed an oath of office in accordance with the requirements of Section 2.20.010 of the Municipal Code.


**Section 3.** This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon approval of the City Council for the City of Leadville.
