**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A SECURITY BREACH PROTOCOL AND
PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION POLICY**

WHEREAS, the Colorado General Assembly enacted C.R.S. §§ 24-73-101, *et seq.* (the “Act”), which requires all governmental entities, including municipalities, to implement data protection policies to prevent the unauthorized use or disclosure of certain kinds of personal information within the City’s custody or control; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to adopt the Security Breach Protocol and Personal Data Protection Policy, attached hereto as **Exhibit 1**, in compliance with the Act.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Leadville, Colorado as follows:

Section 1. Recitals Incorporated. The recitals contained above are incorporated herein by reference and are adopted as findings and determinations of the City Council.

Section 2. Adoption of Policy. The City Council hereby: (1) adopts the Security Breach Protocol and Personal Data Protection Policy (“Policy”) attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** to be effective on June 17, 2020; (2) authorizes the City Attorney, in consultation with the City Administrative Services Manager, to amend the Policy from time to time as may be necessary to be effective upon approval of the Mayor; and (3) authorizes the Mayor to approve any such amendments to the Policy by the City Attorney.


Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon adoption.
