A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A COVID-19 VACCINATION AND TESTING POLICY FOR THE LEADVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, Section 2.44.120 of the Leadville Municipal Code authorizes City Council to promulgate personnel rules and regulations by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Police Commissioner for the Leadville Police Department ("LPD") has requested a COVID-19 vaccination and testing policy for employees of the LPD; and

WHEREAS, following review of the attached COVID-19 Vaccination and Testing Policy, the City Council finds it is in the best interests of the public health, safety and welfare to approve such Policy.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CENTRAL, COLORADO, THAT:

- Section 1. Adoption. The City Council hereby adopts the COVID-19 Vaccination and Testing Policy, attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and incorporated herein by this reference ("Policy"). The Policy shall be effective beginning on December 1, 2021.
- <u>Section 2.</u> <u>Employee Acknowledgements.</u> The City Council directs City staff to take the actions necessary to have all City employees subject to the Policy complete an Employee Acknowledgement, set forth in the Policy, for their personnel files.
- <u>Section 3.</u> <u>Severability.</u> If any part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution is for any reason held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions.
- **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect upon its approval by the City Council.
