**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF LEADVILLE, COLORADO AWARING A BID FOR THE
MOUNTAIN VIEW DRIVE SIGNAL REPLACEMENT PROJECT,
PROJECT NO. C M790-001 (21804)**

WHEREAS, on or about February 8, 2019, the City of Leadville (“City”), solicited proposals for Project No. 19-001, Mountain View Drive Signal Replacement Project (at State Highway 24 & Mountain View Drive) (the “Project”) in accordance with Colorado law by posting a project manual and invitation for bid for the Project (the “IFB”) on the Rocky Mountain Bid Net System; and

WHEREAS, City Staff and the City’s consulting engineer, have evaluated the unit price bids received from bidders to determine the responsible and responsive bidder(s) for the categories of services associated with the Project; and

WHEREAS, City Staff and the City’s consulting engineer have provided their written recommendations regarding the bid award to the Colorado Department of Transportation (“CDOT”); and

WHEREAS, by letter dated April 4, 2019, a copy of which is attached to this Resolution as Exhibit 1, CDOT has approved the award of the bid to TECHNOLOGY CONSTRUCTORS, INC., a Colorado corporation (the “Contractor”), based upon CDOT’s review of the request for concurrence dated April 3, 2019; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire and intent of the City Council to award a construction contract to the responsible and responsive bidder who submitted a bid in compliance with the reasonable and stated specifications contained within the IFB; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, after full consideration of the bids submitted and the recommendations of City Staff, the City’s consulting engineer, and CDOT, desires to award the bid to the Contractor identified in this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the City to award the bid for the Project to the Contractor in the not to exceed amount of One Million One Hundred Ninety-Nine Thousand Seven Hundred Forty-Two Dollars (\$1,199,742.00), based on the unit price(s) set forth in the Contractor’s bid and the estimated work quantities associated with the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into a construction contract with the Contractor to have the Contractor perform the work described with particularity in the IFB and contract documents for the benefit of the City of Leadville, which construction contract shall be in the form incorporated as EXHIBIT A in the IFB (the “Construction Contract”).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Leadville, Colorado as follows:

Section 1. The City Council hereby: (a) awards the Project to the Contractor in the not to exceed amount of One Million One Hundred Ninety-Nine Thousand Seven Hundred Forty-Two Dollars (\$1,199,742.00); (b) authorizes the City Attorney to finalize and to make such changes as may be needed to correct any nonmaterial errors or language or to negotiate such changes to the Construction Contract as may be appropriate that do not substantially increase the obligations of the City; and (c) authorizes the Mayor to execute the Construction Contract on behalf of the City.

Section 2. The City's Administrative Services Manager or Mayor shall be authorized to execute all documents necessary to give effect to the award of the bid referenced in this Resolution, including but not limited to the Notice of Award and the Notice to Proceed.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect upon its adoption by the City Council.
