WHEREAS, the Lake County Office of Emergency Management, with the assistance from Tetra Tech, Inc., has gathered information and prepared the City of Leadville and Lake County, Colorado Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Leadville and Lake County, Colorado Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan has been prepared in accordance with FEMA requirements at 44 C.F.R. 201.6; and,

WHEREAS, a steering committee comprised of members from the private and public sectors of the City of Leadville and Lake County, was convened in order to assess the risks of hazards facing the City and County, and to make recommendations on actions to be taken to mitigate these hazards; and,

WHEREAS, the Lake County Office of Emergency Management is a local unit of government that has afforded the citizens an opportunity to comment and provide input in the Plan and the actions in the Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City of Leadville Mayor and City Council has reviewed the Plan and affirms that the Plan will be updated no less than every five years;

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to reaffirm Lake County's commitment to use the National Incident Management System;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Leadville, Colorado that the City of Leadville adopts the City of Leadville and Lake County, Colorado Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan, as approved by FEMA, as this jurisdiction's Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan, and resolves to execute the actions in the Plan.
